## "SURVIVOR" RULES

### 2017

## Please read this first Survivor Games = Two 20 minute Periods

# Survivor Music is very loud. Please don't ask us to turn it down.

- 1. Every stoppage of play (Fouls, violations, out of bounds, etc.) is direct
- 2. No slide tackling—however goalkeepers are allowed to slide in their box. A goalie's slide must start in the box and due to momentum may carry out, but the goalie may not come out of the box and then slide.
- 3. No one is allowed on player benches except players and coaches. No small children please. Maximum number of coaches 2. One must be over the age of 21.
- 4. No gum, candy, or sunflower seeds on the player's bench or field. Coaches please help us enforce this rule by setting a good example to your players.
- 5. Power Haus reserves the right to combine up to 2 age levels of players if needed to complete a division.
- 6. All divisions are done by age level. We understand that unique circumstances may arise with players, early, or late birthdays ect.
- 7. If the ball hits the side of the net it is out of bounds, ball will be placed 3 ft from the wall where the ball hit. If the ball hits the net behind the goal by the attacking team the opposite team is awarded a goal kick. If the ball hits the net behind the goal by the defending team, the opposite team is awarded a corner kick. If the ball hits the ceiling it is placed at the discretion of the referee and the opposite team is awarded a kick.
- 8. The goalie may handle the ball for up to 5 seconds after gaining control of the ball.
- 9. During regulation Penalty Kicks will be taken from the arc of the box. In the event of a tie---during round robin play teams will take 3 penalty kicks, if tied they will continue sudden death style. Note in penalty kicks entire team must shoot before you have the same player kick twice. This information will be kept in the event of a tiebreaker. The result of game however will stand at a tie.
- 10. No three line rule
- 11. Goalie cannot throw or roll the ball into the opposing goal; however he or she may kick it into the goal.
- 12. If player request 10 ft or if the referee handles the ball. Play cannot restart unless the whistle has been blown.
- 13. Any player receiving a red card will not be allowed to play in the next tournament game.
- 14. For any rule not covered in this section rules will default to Power Haus Rules.

### "SURVIVOR PHASE"

- 15. Last 4 minutes of the second-half selection of who gets the "Sacred Penny" and who will play goalie—these players cannot be voted off. Play will begin at each minute with a drop ball. Clock will run from 4 to 3 with no stoppage. At three minutes players will be voted off and so on, to the last minute. In the last minute however the clock will stop on every stoppage of play if the game is within 3 goals. Players cannot sub during this time unless an injury occurs. In the event of injury the substitute player MUST be the last player voted off during the Survivor round.
- 16. Penalties during the last 4 minutes of play:

4<sup>th</sup> thru 2<sup>nd</sup> minute- Any yellow card that would normally result in a 2 minute penalty will cease at either the opposing team scoring a goal or the end of that minute of play (clock stoppage)

<u>Last minute of play</u> - If at any place on the field a deliberate foul occurs (as determined by the referee) a **Penalty Kick** will be awarded to the opposing

team. Teams will not be made to play a man short during the last minute of play.

17. In "The Show" (Championship Game) if you end at a tie during the survivor you will play a sudden death survivor to decide the winner. If you are still tied you will go to (5) Penalty Kicks from the arc. In the event of a tie after PKS you will go to sudden death PKS. Note in penalty kicks entire team must shoot before you have the same

player kick twice.

- 1. Head to Head Result
- 2. Least Goals Allowed
- 3. Most Goals Scored
- 4. Result of Penalty Kicks after a tie in pool play
- 5. 5 Penalty kicks from the arc
- 6. Flip of a coin

First Place and Second Place awards will be awarded

Final Word—this tournament is designed for the players to have fun. Please encourage good sportsmanship and fair play and instruct your players, assistant coaches, and parents to not yell or debate with referees(s).
